

## Finham Primary Behaviour Policy – COVID 19 Addendum

This addendum is to be used in conjunction with and alongside our current behaviour policy. The rationale behind its creation is to ensure that the children at Finham Primary School act in a manner that fully supports the very necessary measures that have been but in place during the Covid -19 pandemic.

Some behaviour concerns referred to in this addendum may have previously been deemed less serious, however, if an action now results in the potential compromising of a person's ability to social distance and stay safe it will now be treated in a more serious manner.

Due to social distancing, we will be unable to complete the following actions:

- Share teaching with other teachers and classes
- Hold assemblies outside each bubble
- Hold end of year performances

Linked to the above, the actions we will take are as follows:

- Staff reminder of appropriate expectations
- Values certificates within each bubble.

Concern examples	
Not taking responsibility to inform an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of Coronavirus. Not following expectations about coughing, sneezing, tissues and disposal (catch it, bin it, kill it) Very Low level disruption in bubble	Any breaches behaviour will be dealt with seriously by senior leaders in school on a case by case basis.
Repeated incidents from 1 Not following school routine on arrival or departure Not following the rules related to sharing equipment – age appropriate Not following instructions on hygiene, such as handwashing or sanitising Not moving around school as per specific instructions Not following social distancing rules wherever possible	These may result in children not been allowed to return to school.
Repeated incidents of level 2 Deliberately tampering with another child's equipment Deliberately tampering with hygiene materials or bins Deliberately entering an area or zone that is out of bounds or which may compromise the health of children and staffing another bubble Deliberately attempting to socialise with children from another bubble Deliberately misusing the toilet area and other facilities	
Deliberately coughing or spitting at somebody. Any action that would usually require the need for restraint and which would seriously compromise staff's ability to remain socially distanced
