Finham Primary School have introduced a Mobile Phone Policy in order to ensure that children and families are able to use mobile phones for this purpose, whilst ensuring that phones are not used in school in any other way.

Mobile phones need to be brought to the main office at the start of the school day and collected from the main office after school.

If a child is found to have a mobile phone which has not been handed in to the school office, then the mobile phone will be taken from them for safe keeping and an appointment arranged for it to be handed to the parent.

Finham Primary School reserves the right to ban a child from bringing a mobile phone to school if it is used inappropriately, including having access to social media sites with age restrictions above primary school age.

Finham Primary School is not liable for any loss or damage to mobile phones.

If you would like your children to do this we need to have the attached slip signed, dated and returned to the school office.

Any phones found without this agreement will be placed in the school safe for their safety and a meeting will need to be arranged with Mrs Bracken to have it returned. It will not be the responsibility of the office staff to safely return the phones.
