In year 2, the children have been enjoying their work on traditional tales and in their English lessons, they are currently working on the story 'Rapunzel'. This tale tells the story of Rapunzel who gets trapped in a tower by a wicked witch. But rather than waiting around for a prince to save her, Rapunzel decides to take on the witch herself and comes up with a secret plan to get rid of the witch once and for all. The children have really enjoyed exploring the story and this week, they have used adjectives, adverbs and similes to describe Rapunzel's secret hiding place. Last week, year 3 visited Twycross Zoo to consolidate their learning on animals and humans. They had a brilliant day viewing the different animals and particularly enjoyed seeing the giraffes, penguins and monkeys. Back in school, they are continuing their work on Greek myths and have started learning about Ancient Greece in their history lessons.

In their maths lessons, year 1 have been working on fractions and have been learning how to recognise and find halves and quarters of objects and shapes. They have also been working on their computing skills and earlier in the week, enjoyed creating a simple code for a beebot to follow ensuring that they work out how to avoid certain obstacles.
