UPPER PHASE NEWSLETTER

This week, Year 4 have explored Coventry's identity as a city of peace and reconciliation, delving into its historical connections with the cathedral, as part of their R.E lessons. In Geography, they investigated deforestation, examining its environmental impacts. The children produced informative non-chronological reports in their books, showcasing well-organised factual paragraphs. Additionally, they developed their mapping skills by reading Ordnance Survey maps and identifying key features.

Year 5 have been continuing their learning about the plants in science. They have discovered why flowers are important, particularly the process of pollination, which is vital for many plants to grow and produce new seeds. Students explored the life cycle of a flower at a Year 5 standard, learning about each stage, from seed to bloom, and how pollination fits into this process. Additionally, they created classification flow diagrams to help identify different plants based on how they reproduce, making connections to their physical features.

This week, Year 6 have been learning important skills to help them get ready to transition into Year 7. St Martin's Church came to speak to the children about starting secondary school, and they worked in groups to discuss tips and strategies for a smooth transition in September. The children have also been practising hard for their last primary school production, working on songs, dance routines, and their lines.

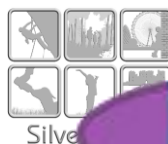
